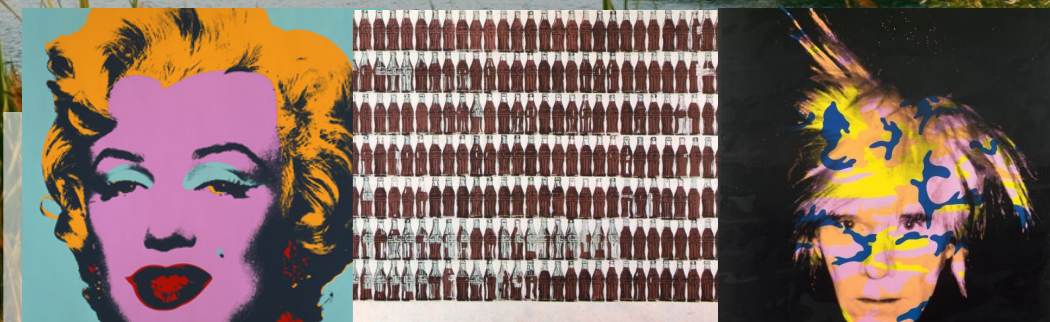

Workshop Series at ScOLA

Andy Warhol: King of Pop Art



Art advances academic achievement by enhancing critical and creative thinking skills in addition to the pleasure of its beauty and emotional power. Advanced level students of ScOLA had the opportunity to be involved in an art workshop during the 2013- 2014 academic years entitled "Andy Warhol: King of Pop Art". A two-hour-lecture was designed by Neslihan Sabuncu to raise awareness for art and improve analysis and synthesis skills.



During the first session of the workshop, students were asked to view the exhibited paintings on the walls as if they were in an art gallery and then to write down their feelings about the works of art. After some students read their reflections, the lecture about pop art and Andy Warhol was completed. In the second session of the workshop, students worked in groups. They chose one of the exhibited artworks and worked on it by describing,

relating, analyzing, interpreting, and evaluating with the guidance of a task sheet. Next, one student from every group gave a mini presentation about the group's outcome. After every presentation, the artist's intention to create the artwork was explained and compared to the group's interpretation. When all of the mini presentations were completed, students wrote their reflections again and shared them with the class.

This workshop contributed to the students' awareness of art. The students were able to compare and contrast their understanding of art before and after the lecture.
